Greetings! Yes, it is time again for Registration for the upcoming school year of September 2011 through May 2012.

Religion class instructions for all grades will be held on either Wednesday afternoons or Sunday mornings as indicated below.

Wednesdays: 3:45 P.M. to 5 P.M. - Grades 1 through 5

Wednesdays: 4 P.M. to 5:15p.m. - Grades 6 and 7

Sundays: 9:10 A.M. to 10:20 A.M. Grades 1 through 7, in addition to class Attendance at the 10:30 A.M. Family Mass.

****Kindly note, students in Grades 3 and up, who have not received the sacraments of baptism and Holy Communion, these classes will only be available on Sundays mornings. If a child is not baptized, please submit a birth certificate.**

The enclosed registration application indicates the applicable annual fees.

Check payments should be made to **Our Lady of Angels Religious Education.**

You may make the registration payment in two installments, if this helps you.

Please **select classes for Wednesday afternoons or Sunday mornings.** Please return the completed application as early as possible or no later than August 1st so that a textbook and supplies are available for your child when the program begins.

The application can be dropped off at the rectory or put in the collection at Mass. Additional applications can be obtained online at our parish website: ourladyofangelsparish.org. under the heading of Faith Formation or come into the Office on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 10:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. during the months of June/July. Please call beforehand to insure that someone is available to assist you. Please inform your friends and neighbors, **Registration for New Students is taking place in June**

on Wednesdays/Thursdays 10a.m.-3p.m.or Sundays between 9a.m.to 12 p.m.

Classes begin on Sunday, September 18th and Wednesday, September 21st.
