Our Lady of Champion

"Do not be afraid; I will help you.

The National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion is a Catholic Shrine to Mary, Mother of Jesus, located within the Roman Catholic Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin in the United States. It stands at the site of the reported Apparition of Mary in 1859 to Adele Brise, a Belgian-born woman.

The apparition was formally approved on December 8, 2010, by Bishop David L. Ricken, DD, DCL, becoming the first Marian Apparition approved by the Catholic Church in the United States. Bishop Ricken also approved the chapel as a diocesan shrine, recognizing its long history as a place of pilgrimage and prayer. On August 15, 2016, the U.S. Conference of Bishops designated the shrine as The National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion.

The image of Our Lady of Champion was dedicated on May 9, 2024 in the Adoration Chapel at Our Lady of Angels Church in recognition of this blessed event and for prayerful devotion to Our Lady.

FAITH FORMATION FOR CHILDREN : Preparation to Receive Sacraments

All the children in Our Lady of Angels Parish who are in Grades 1-8 attending public, charter or private schools should be enrolled in Religious Education classes yearly in order to grow in our faith and prepare to receive the Sacraments. Registration will only be completed in the Religious Education Office (located in the school building in the 9/11 courtyard) during office hours. If you are registering in our program for the first time, please bring your child's birth certificate and baptism certificate. There is also a \$50 registration fee.
